May 28—We will be celebrating the Arab culture with tea, bread and various edible items.

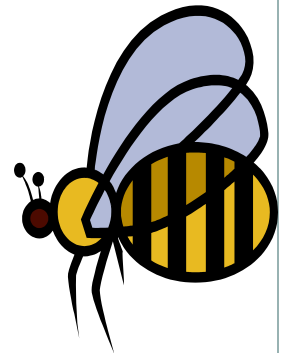
